

Application guidelines for a Project Cooperation with Vets United

Our **mission** is to improve animal welfare for companion, farm and wild animals in developing and newly industrialised countries sustainably through theoretical and practical training in the veterinary field.

Eligible Applicants

Eligible to apply are:

- veterinary educational institutions
- animal welfare organisations, animal clinics or wildlife center which conduct or plan to conduct their own veterinary training
- animal welfare organisations, animal clinics or wildlife center which conduct or plan to conduct veterinary training in cooperation with a local veterinary educational institution.

We postulate for eligible applicants experiences in cooperation with international institutions and the ability to integrate the training program in the long term.

Aims and Scope of the Cooperation:

Vets United is a veterinary training programme to improve animal welfare through the sharing of skills and expertise for better veterinary care. The training courses will be planned and run jointly by Vets United and the partner organisation. The idea of the programme is to repeat the courses regularly in cooperation with Vets United until they can be run independently by the partner organisation. The partner organisation provides all facilities on site during the training period. WTG provides the training supervisors, course material and funds the courses. Details on the training course will be defined in the cooperation agreement.

Application Procedure:

Applications can be made at any time. For the application please use the standard application form. An application does not create a legal entitlement for cooperation.

Amount of funding:

WTG covers all expenses incurred by the training course. The amount of funding will be decided individually for each application. Requirement for any funding is the signing of the cooperation agreement.
